
## Link It!

*Prayer is how we talk to God. Sometimes we write down our prayers and when we read them again later on in life, we can see how God was faithful.*

1. Write a prayer to God on a strip of paper this size. Get everyone in your family to make their own. You can help each other with writing your prayers!



2. Cut it out.
3. Tape or staple the ends of the paper strip together to form a circle.
4. Then thread the next strip into the next circle and staple the ends together. You will start to notice a chain forming like this one.
